Arlington Public Schools will provide [free grab-and-go breakfasts and lunches](#) starting March 16 at the following two school sites:

- Kenmore Middle School, 200 S. Carlin Springs Road
- Dr. Charles R. Drew Elementary School, 3500 S. 23rd Street

Meals will be set up on a table outside the building for distribution from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday-Friday. One lunch for that day and one breakfast to take home for the following day will be provided. These meals will be free to any child aged 2 to 18. The child must be present to receive the meals; no meals will be given to parents without the child present.

Alexandria City Public Schools will be providing [emergency meals at no cost](#) for any child under 18 and any family who needs it starting Monday, March 16. Families can get food two ways:

- Individual Meals to Go: Any child between the ages of 2 and 18, whether or not they are eligible for Free or Reduced Price Meals, can pick up a meal to go in a bag by stopping by the Chinguapin Drive side of T.C. Williams High School (door 14) between 8 a.m. and 1 p.m. You do not need to fill out any forms to pick up a meal-to-go.
- Family Meal Packs: You can order a family meal pack online and pick it up at the drive through pick-up point outside Chinguapin Recreation Center (Chinguapin Drive side of T.C. Williams High School, door 14) between 8 a.m. and 1 p.m. the following day. If transportation is an issue, please remember to check the box to request meal delivery. Fill out the form to request a family meal pack by clicking [HERE](#).

Fairfax County Schools will serve [breakfast and lunch at specific locations](#), at no cost to students, with adult lunches available for purchase for \$2. Breakfast will be available from 8:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. and lunch will be available from 10:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Monday through Friday at the following locations:

Loudoun County Public Schools is supporting families by continuing to provide meal service in our school communities while schools are closed. ***Free breakfast and lunch will be served daily at all schools*** during the period of school closure. Meal service will run from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. Meals will be available at each school and students will be allowed to receive two meals daily (a breakfast and a lunch) and can choose to take both meals simultaneously. Meals will be distributed outside school buildings in a designated area that will vary from school to school. Meals can also be picked up at [select community centers and churches](#) throughout the county
