*** Note: Health Service Fee for JumpStart Students is \$62.50. Health Service Fee is required for all part-time and full-time undergraduate, graduate, and ELI students for summer enrollment.

***Tuition - Graduate:** Amount indicated is for full-time graduate students with 9 to 18 credits. The tuition rate per credit for 1-8 (part-time students) or over 18 credits (in addition to the full-time tuition charge) is \$1,010 for U.S. graduate students, \$2,020 for international graduate students from non-developing countries and \$1,515 for international graduate students from developing countries.

Undergraduate: Amount indicated is for full-time undergraduate students with 12 to 18 credits. The tuition rate per credit for 1-11 (part-time students) or over 18 credits (in addition to full-time tuition charge) is \$688 for U.S. undergraduate students, \$1,376 for international undergraduate students from non-developing countries and \$1,032 for international undergraduate students from developing countries.

*Fees are subject to change.

*This reflects the international surcharge at 100% for students from non-developing countries and 50% for students from developing countries.

** **Health Insurance:** It applies only to full-time students unless a proof of adequate insurance coverage is submitted to the Student Financial Services. Students enrolling full-time in summer session 2019 are billed \$786 for coverage from May 1, 2019 to July 31, 2019.

Additional Costs and Fees For Summer 2019

Undergraduate Application Fee	\$50 — Required for all undergraduate applicants and students applying for readmission.
Graduate Application Fee	\$75 — Required for all new graduate applicants and students applying for readmission, \$40 for each additional application
Undergraduate Enrollment Fee	\$200 — Required for all students accepting admission to the University.
Graduate Enrollment Fee	\$100 — Required for admission process
Graduate Continuous Enrollment Fee	\$100 — Required for all graduate students registering for Continuous Enrollment, GPS 798 or GPS 898.
Late Registration Fee	\$50 — Required for all students who complete registration after the official registration dates.
Add/Drop Fee	\$5 — Required for each add/drop transaction.
Book, Supplies, and Class Materials Fee	Varies — Estimated amount a student needs each semester is approximately \$300-\$400. Some classes charge additional fees to cover the cost of special services or class materials.
Parking Fee	\$20 — Required each semester for students who register their cars to park on campus.
Graduation Fee	\$50 — Required for all degree candidates during the semester of graduation.
JumpStart Program Fee	\$425 — Available for freshman and transfer students.

Summer 2019 Meal Plan

If you attend Gallaudet's Summer Sessions and live in the dorms, you are required to participate in the Summer Meal Plan program. The Summer Sessions operate from Monday, May 20 - Friday, August 9, 2019. Each meal plan is a **suggested** Dining Dollar amount that should carry you through the number of weeks you select. This is an estimation based on 1 - 2 a la carte meals and 1 dinner service per day at approximately \$30/day. Dining Dollars can be used in the MarketPlace for breakfast and lunch from 7am - 2pm. Dinner locations will be announced prior to the start of Session 1 and will be served from 5pm - 7pm. Dining dollars are non-refundable. All students must purchase a Summer Meal Plan - Dining Dollars, during the **Summer Online Business Registration process**. You are also required to purchase Summer Meal Plan-Dining Dollars if you live in the dorms after May 20th. You can purchase/add Dining Dollars by logging into your Bison account. Below are the suggested Summer Meal Plan-Dining Dollar options, broken down for ease of selection.

Session 1 - 3 weeks	May 20th - June 7th	\$630 Dining Dollars
Session 2 - 3 weeks	June 10th - June 28th	\$630 Dining Dollars
Session 1 - 4 weeks	May 20th - June 14th	\$840 Dining Dollars
Session 1 - 6 weeks	May 20th - June 28th	\$1,260 Dining Dollars
Session 1 - 10 weeks	May 20th - July 26th	\$2,100 Dining Dollars
Full Summer Program 12 weeks	May 20th - August 9th	\$2,520 Dining Dollars

Each week costs approximately \$260 Dining Dollars for 3 meals per week day and 2 meals per weekend day, please identify the week/s you'll be living on campus and multiply by weekly charge, remember you can add dining dollars anytime, so please add only what you know you will use as there are no refunds.
