Event Overview

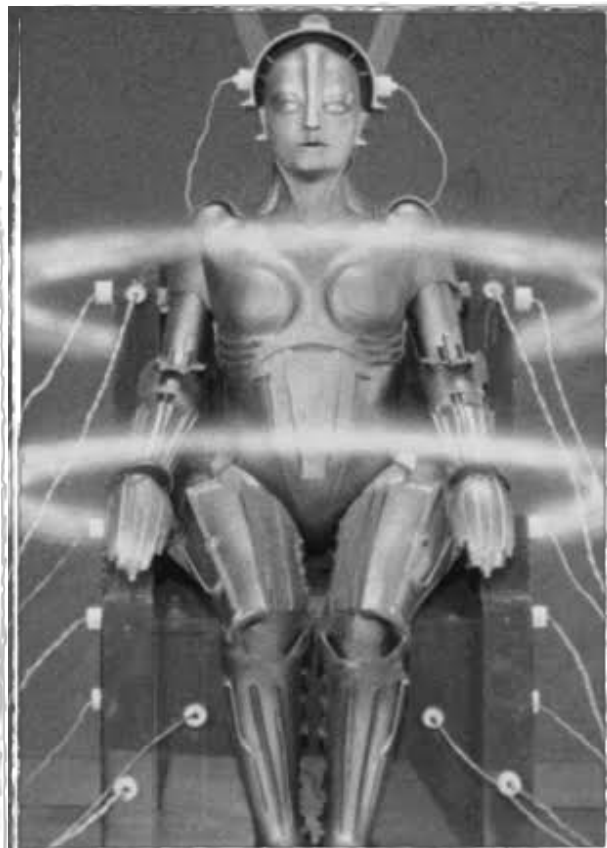
